Day 1: Setting Sail on Lake Kariba

Welcome to Zimbabwe, Lake Kariba, the largest man-made lake by volume, where, the sunsets are breathtaking, the hippos are talking and the adventure is waiting.

Either Starting from Kariba Main Airport or at Andora Harbour, there will be a member from our team eagerly awaiting your arrival, rearing to show off Kariba's beauty.

Once boarded, the Malachite Houseboat crew will set sail to Gordons Bay, which is part of the Matusadona National Park Shoreline, this should take about 6 hours, during this time, you'll be served lunch and have the chance to take in the scenery, relax and enjoy. Upon Arrival at Gordons Bay, the fishing rods will be set up, cooler boxes packed and the tender boats ready to take you fishing, birding or game viewing.

A very relaxing start to day one, ending off the day with the Kariba Sunset a lovely meal and a good social evening.



Day 2: Sailing, Fishing and Game-Viewing in Matusadona

As you glide along to Tashinga, immerse yourself in the expansive beauty of Lake Kariba, listening to the calls of fish eagles and the playful sounds of hippos, all while savoring a delightful meal.


Upon reaching Tashinga, you can a game drive with African Parks in Matusadona and then trying your luck with some fishing, enjoying all of this whilst basking in the African sun and enjoying the wonders of the wilderness.

Day 3: Relaxing and Sunset Watching

Enjoy a bit of early morning fishing and birding, to come back to the Houseboat to start your cruise across to Changa. Enjoy breakfast on the go, relaxing, and enjoying the wide-open space.

There is never a dull moment whilst cruising, going past the dead tree stumps, the little birds chirping at you and enjoying the Swallows that follow the boat. catch a glimpse of the elephants and hippos on the shoreline too!

Changa is a small triangle, located in-between Spurwing Island, Fothergill Island and Matusadona Mainland, just next to Changa National Parks office- this spot is known for the antelope and birdlife- as well as stunning sunsets over the dead trees.

WHAT TO BRING

Please keep all your luggage to a maximum of 10kg in a duffel bag if flying.

We recommend you pack the following for your Safari:

- Reusable Water Bottles
- Swimming/bathing costume
- Shorts and T-shirts

- Shirts (including a long sleeved one for sun protection)
- A kikoi (or sarong) to cover your legs to protect them from the sun.
- Torch or flashlight and extra batteries
- Camera, film and spare camera batteries
- Binoculars
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent
- Please ensure that you advise Zambezi Drift or your travel agent of any medical or dietary requirements **at least 14 days before your trip departs.**
- **Please note that the route may change due to weather/ water conditions.**
- **If a different Route is requested, please advise when enquiring and we will adjust the fuel costings.**
- **There will be no boarding of any houseboat after 3:30pm.**

- Transfers to and From Kariba Main Airport, however, a discount will not be given if guests do not need transfers.
- The Houseboat does supply cleaning supplies, however, we do not offer laundry services.
